Process:

+ Recruit and Train Facilitators:

+ Form Dialogue Communities:

Facilitators invite people from the local neighborhood community to come to an initial dialogue on race relations. The goal is to achieve mutual understanding through deep listening

+ Further Facilitator Training:

Facilitators participate in monthly webinars to prepare future dialogue session, moving the community toward greater social and spiritual wellness.
